# Strategic Thrust for 2026

## CALL TO ACTION

Wage a coordinated, whole-of-state and whole-of-society campaign against crime, corruption and gender-based violence and femicide, anchored on intelligence-led policing, effective prosecution, secure borders and active community mobilisation under ANC political leadership.

# 2026 Delivery Overview

- Ensure criminal justice reforms translate into visible safety and justice outcomes.
- Restore public confidence by implementing Madlanga Commission recommendations,
- Strengthen intelligence capability, and integrate the operational modalities of JCPS, SAPS, NPA, IDAC, DHA, BMA and DCS.

# Key Role: SAPS & Intelligence

- SAPS to intensify visible and intelligence-led policing, disrupt organized crime networks, address internal corruption and restore discipline.
- Intelligence structures to provide early warning, counter criminal infiltration and support proactive operations.

# Key Role: JCPS, NPA and IDAC

- JCPS Cluster to operate as an integrated system and ensure effective collaboration with other government clusters.
- NPA and IDAC to prioritise high-impact corruption, organised crime and GBVF prosecutions and ensure that arrests lead to convictions and asset recovery.

# Key Role: DHA, BMA and DCS

- DHA to strengthen immigration control and identity integrity.
- BMA to secure borders against illegal migration & the illicit smuggling of goods while ensure the legitimate movement of people & goods.
- DCS to prevent criminal command-and-control from correctional facilities and reduce recidivism.

# ALL ANC Branches & Community Structures

- ANC branches, CPFs and mass democratic formations to mobilise communities for crime prevention, social cohesion and GBVF interventions,
- Collectively reinforce the principle that safety is a shared responsibility across the entire national ecosystem.

*Firm action against non-performance and corruption, including political accountability, disciplinary processes and criminal prosecution, reinforcing ethical leadership and state integrity.*

# RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen Security at courts
- Prioritise the de-militarisation & professionalisation of the police service
- Wastage of state resources on withdrawal of GBVF cases – develop sanctions against the practice
- Permanent presence of police at institutions of higher learning incorporated into visible policing in the fight against GBVF
- incorporate into the basic and higher education curriculum a compulsory module on socialization against violence and especially GBVF
- Consider the introduction of compulsory conscription

# Recommendations continued...

- Intensify and enhance Visible policing in township
- Intensify fight against corruption and Implement (National Anti Corruption Strategy (NACS )
- The heightened crime situation in the hotspot areas requires a heightened response,
- Allocate more resources for criminal justice cluster
- Priorities stability of crime intelligence
- Urgent attention must be given to the intelligence structures of the country and bolster their capacity through requisite resources.
- Deploy the requisite technological resources in correctional facilities to address criminality.

# Recommendations continued...

- Allocate resources to adequately deal with the scourge of GBVF in all phases (Prevention, Investigation and victim support)
- Audit the firearms in the custody of private security companies.
- Improve the coordination of peace and stability including the integration of the criminal justice system
- Phase out sourcing private security in core assets of the state, critical infrastructure and national key points
- Prioritise the boy child
- Decisively Address the scourge of alcohol and drug abuse
- Consider establishing a dedicated specialized Anti- drug unit within SAPS
